## FOR A DRIVERS LICENSE IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO

If you hold a drivers license from your home country, which was issued in the past 24 months or earlier, you are eligible to apply for a G-2 without a wait period, although you are required to write the G-1 written exam.

Documents required:

- 1. I.D (passport, visa)
- 2. Photographs
- 3. Required fees

Upon submitting the above documents, you can take the G-1 written test, which, upon completion allows you to book an appointment for the G-2 driving test.

-Usually a couple of driving lessons are required to become familiarized with local road laws. There are a multitude of different driving schools that can be found in the Yellow Pages.

Upon successful completion of G-1 and G-2 exams you will receive a G-2 license that allows you to drive in Canada.
