- 45 Hours of Ground School (highly recommended)
- Student Pilot Permit Age 14, Application Age 16
- Category 4 Medical Certification through your Family Doctor.
- Successfully complete (60%) on Transport Canada Recreational Pilot Written Exam
- 15 Hrs Dual Flight Training Minimum
- 10 Hrs Solo Flight Training Minimum
- Successfully Complete a Recreational Pilot Flight Test
